



## **ESPM202 Project Scope Management**

The purpose of this course is to cover the processes of initiation, scope planning, scope definition, scope verification, and scope change control. Real-world examples will be used to show how to properly define a project and how to accurately document the changes.

At the conclusion of this course, participants should be able to:

- Identify the five processes of scope management as defined by the PMI
- Create a clear and concise scope statement that includes all required work, and only the required work, to complete the project successfully
- Create a work breakdown structure (WBS)
- Verify that the scope for a given project has been successfully completed
- List techniques for controlling scope and scope creep
