

ESTOL308 Retrofit Installation

This course is designed to explain the three P's of retrofitting: planning, patience, and practice. The course will cover specific ways to address the challenges of installing equipment and cable in an existing home. It also includes tips and techniques on how and when to use specific retrofitting tools. ESTOL308 is equivalent to a 90-minute instructor-led course.

Course Objectives:

- Discuss how to plan and organize a retrofitting project which minimizes the impact to the existing client's existing home
- List five standard retrofitting tools and elaborate on how and when to use them
- Describe how and where to use tools for making holes, pulling and locating wire, and making wall openings
- Implement retrofitting techniques in three different construction settings
