Height Restrictions

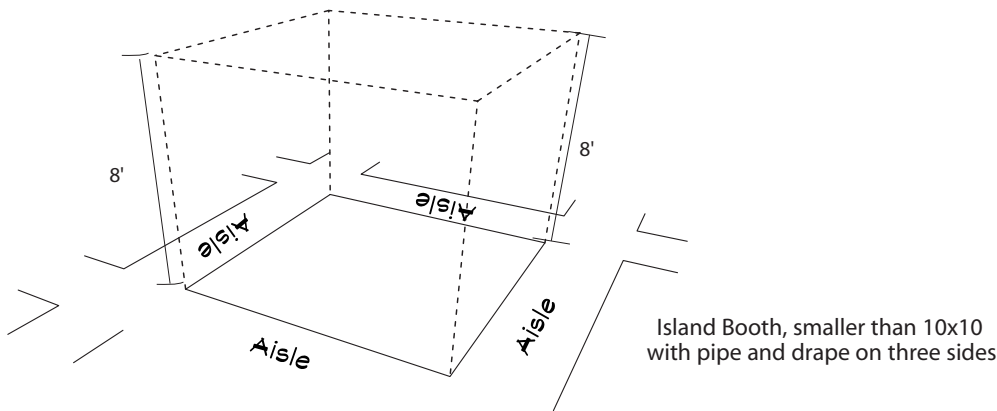
Island Booth, smaller than 20'x20'

An Island Booth is a booth exposed to aisles on all four sides. However, booths smaller than 20'x20' have different restrictions than Island Booths larger than 20'x20'.

Use of Space

The entire cubic content of the space may be used up to the maximum allowable height, which is eight feet (8'). Pipe and drape will be placed on three sides of the space, unless a request is made for the space to be open on all four sides. The maximum height extends to twenty feet (20') in all areas if pipe and drape is removed.

Hanging signs are not permitted in Island Booths smaller than 20'x20'.

Island Booth, 20'x20' or larger

An Island Booth is a booth exposed to aisles on all four sides.

Use of Space

The entire cubic content of the space may be used up to the maximum allowable height, which is twenty feet (20').

Hanging signs are permitted only in Island Booths 20'x20' and larger.
