EPA Deadline For Compliance was **April 22, 2010.**  
**Is Your Company Compliant?**

## Don't Delay. Get Certified and Avoid Costly Penalties.

The answer is YES if:

- Your company works in residences built before 1978.
- Your company works in buildings occupied by pregnant women or children under the age of six.
- Your company renovates, repairs, or paints in areas more than six sq.ft. on an interior room or twenty sq.ft. on an exterior wall.

**\*\*Uncertified companies who provide these services are subject to penalties up to \$37,500 per violation, per day.**

In cooperation with the **National Center for Healthy Housing (NCHH)** and other EPA-accredited training providers, **CEDIA** is now hosting the two-part Certified Lead Renovator course, which includes both an online component and a hands-on component. The online portion of the training will be available through the CEDIA e-Learning platform, and the hands-on lab portion of the training will be hosted by CEDIA at select **ADI** locations throughout the U.S.

# Is your business affected by the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Renovation, Repair, and Painting Rule?

## **Part 1: Lead Safety For Renovation, Repair, and Painting - Online**

**Level:** All

**Fee:** \$49.00

**Time:** Anytime, Anywhere

The focus of this course is to train renovation, repair, and painting contractors how to work safely in housing with lead-based paint. You will learn how to handle lead-based dust in buildings constructed prior to 1978. This is a pre-requisite course for the lab portion required in conjunction with the certification exam. After completing this course, you will need to complete an on-site, hands-on performance assessment and score 80% on the written exam to demonstrate you are able to effectively manage a renovation project and comply with the rules.

Learning Outcomes:

- Identify the health problems associated with disturbing LBP

- Outline why the EPA issued its 2008 rule requiring lead-safe work practices

- Determine how the EPA rule affects your work and how to set up a work area to contain dust and debris and simplify clean up

- Understand how to train workers you supervise so they follow the rules, clean up lead-based dust and properly dispose of waste

The focus of this course is to apply skills learned in the Part One training in order to demonstrate hands-on capability to work safely in housing with lead-based paint. You will demonstrate how to handle lead-based dust in buildings constructed prior to 1978.

Learning Outcomes:

- Demonstrate practical steps to avoid making dust that may contain lead

- Demonstrate methods to contain any dust you create when disturbing old paint

- Demonstrate how to clean-up dust that is not contained

- Understand the documentation process to confirm accurate work practices

- Understand work practices that will keep renovators safe and reduce liability exposure
