### Student membership Cost, Requirements, and Policy

**CEDIA's Student membership is available to anyone who is 17 years of age or older and is currently enrolled at an educational institute.**

- Student applicants must supply a copy of their school ID as proof of enrollment in a high school, vocational school, or undergraduate study at a two- or four-year educational institute.
- Cost of a student membership is \$25 USD annually.
- ESPA Certified-EST® who are currently enrolled in school will receive a free one-year student membership.
- ESPA Certified-EST® must show proof that they passed the exam.
- Membership will expire one year after graduation and/or upon being hired by a CEDIA member company.
- Students must show a current student ID each year they renew their membership.
