



Notes from Central Contractor Registration Handbook & Central Contractor Registration FAQs

You must have a Data Universal Numbering System (D-U-N-S) Number in order to begin the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) process.

Information needed to register

Data Universal Numbering System (D-U-N-S) Number: The Data Universal Numbering System (D-UN-S) Number is a unique nine-character identification number provided by the commercial company Dun & Bradstreet (D&B). Call D&B at **1-866-705-5711** or access their website at fedgov.dnb.com/webform/ if you do not have a D-U-N-S Number. The process to request a D-U-N-S Number via phone takes about 10 minutes and is free of charge. Internet requests are fulfilled within 24 hours. Once a D-U-N-S Number has been issued, it will be available for use in CCR within 24 hours.

Goods/Services Section

North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Codes: NAICS Codes are mandatory codes for the CCR that classify the type of business an organization offers. NAICS Codes were created to replace SIC codes. NAICS Codes are a method for classifying business establishments. You must supply at least one for your registration to be complete. If you do not know your NAICS codes, you may perform a search at www.census.gov/epcd/naics07. You must use six-digit NAICS Codes in your registration. You can add or change NAICS Codes at any time.

NAICS Codes related to residential electronic system contractors

- 238210: Home Theater installation
- 238210: Electrical Contractors and Other Wiring Installation Contractors
- 443112: Radio, Television, and Other Electronics Stores
- 561621: Security Systems Services (except Locksmiths)

Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Codes

SIC Codes classify the type of business an organization offers. Use this section to list all the classification codes that apply to your products and services. Be sure to list as many as apply. SIC codes can be four or eight digits, all numeric. You must supply at least one valid SIC code for your registration to be complete. If you do not know your SIC codes, you may perform a search at www.osha.gov/oshstats/sicser.html.

SIC Codes related to residential electronic system contractors

- 5731: Radio, Television, and Consumer Electronics Stores
- 3651: Household Audio & Video Equipment
- 3645: Residential Electric Lighting Fixtures
- 7382: Security Systems Services
- 3643: Current-carrying wiring devices
- 1731: Electrical work
